Purpose and Audience

The dynamic nature of the HIV epidemic, and the rapidly growing body of information on how it affects women in particular, require providers to update their understanding on a regular basis. The Colorado Women's HIV Consortium is providing this forum to address the growing impact of HIV and AIDS among women and to promote proper and comprehensive care of HIV-infected women. The target audience includes physicians, registered nurses, mid-level providers and others caring for HIV-infected women.

Objectives

- ♀ Explain key treatment and research issues in advancing care for HIV+ women.
- ♀ Discuss considerations and complications of anti-retroviral regimens for women.
- ♀ Describe the hormonal profile of women with HIV during the menopausal transition.
- ♀ Relate key considerations in HIV management of a depressed patient, including medication effects and interactions.
- ♀ State the desired health profile of an HIV-infected woman before attempting pregnancy.
- ♀ Review PAP smear screening guidelines and management of abnormal results in HIV-infected women.
- ♀ Implement effective clinical care of a substance-using HIV patient, including attention to recreational and treatment drugs interactions with HAART.

The Colorado Women's HIV Consortium is a collaboration among women living with HIV infection, the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center Infectious Disease Division, the CHIP program at The Children's Hospital, the Colorado AIDS Education and Training Center, Denver Public Health ID/AIDS Clinic at Denver Health Medical Center; US DHHS Office on Women's Health, Region VIII, and the Women's Lighthouse Project.

From North

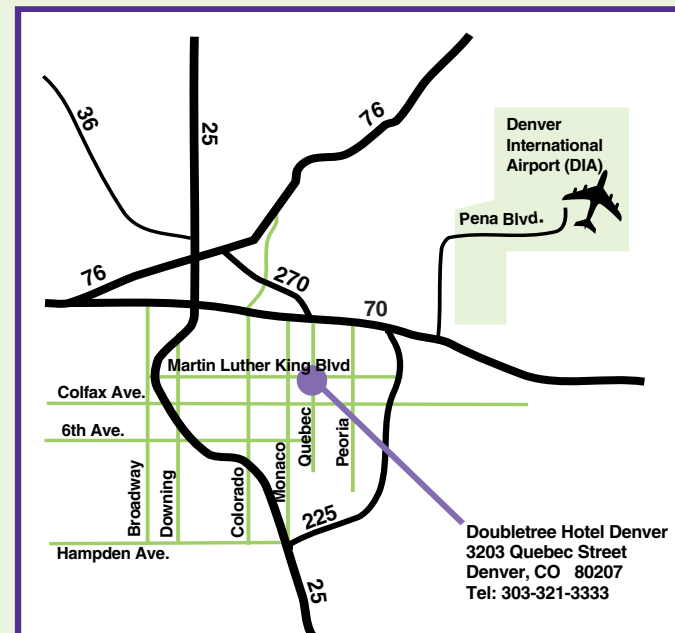
