Purpose and Audience

The dynamic nature of the HIV epidemic, and the rapidly growing body of information on how it affects women in particular, require providers to update their knowledge on a regular basis. The Colorado Women's HIV Consortium is providing this forum to address the growing impact of HIV and AIDS among women and to promote proper and comprehensive care of HIV-infected women. The target audience includes physicians, registered nurses, mid-level providers and others caring for HIV-infected women.

Objectives

- ♀ Discuss considerations and complications of antiretroviral regimens for women.
- ♀ Review HCV epidemiology and the course of disease in HIV-infected women.
- ♀ Discuss common skin manifestations associated with HIV infection.
- ♀ Recognize oral manifestations associated with HIV infection.
- ♀ Review HIV and/or HAART-associated metabolic and endocrine concerns for HIV-infected women.
- ♀ Explain the role of microbicides in HIV prevention.
- ♀ Review key factors in conducting a medical work-up of a female immigrant or refugee HIV patient.

The Colorado Women's HIV Consortium is a collaboration among women living with HIV infection, the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center Infectious Disease Division, the CHIP program at The Children's Hospital, the Colorado AIDS Education and Training Center, Denver Public Health ID/AIDS Clinic at Denver Health Medical Center; US DHHS Office on Women's Health, Region VIII, and the Women's Lighthouse Project.

From Denver International Airport

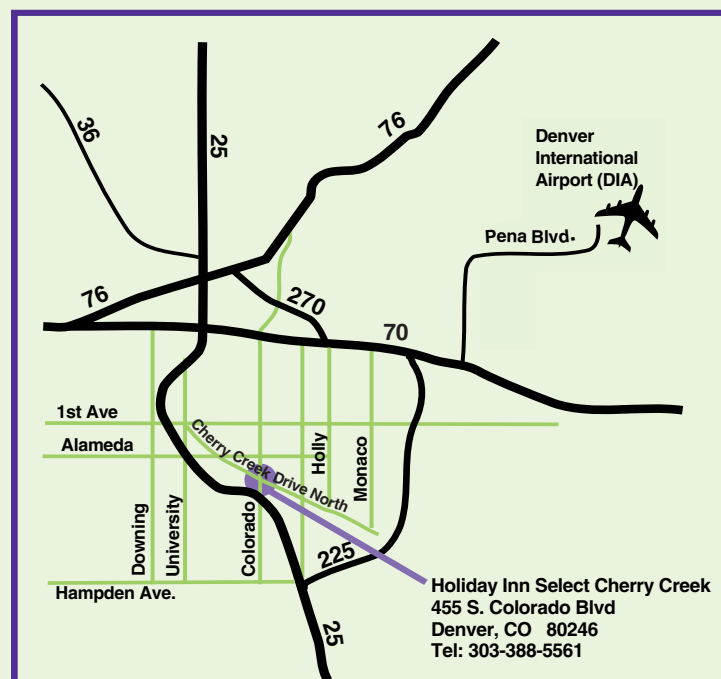
